Appendix B: Comparison of 2004-05 Sample of Agencies with Total Population of Funded Agencies

NOTE: From July 2001 to December 2004, the Cal-SAFE Program agencies used the GradStar Management Information System (MIS) to collect and store detailed information on the students and children served. Each month the agencies uploaded their local information to the state-wide GradStar Database. However, in December 2004, the state-wide GradStar Database ceased operation. Many agencies continued to use their local GradStar MIS to gather information even though they no longer submitted the information to the state-wide database. In an attempt to gather more detailed information on students and their children than could be gained from the two Cal-SAFE Program pages within the Consolidated Application, agencies were asked to voluntarily submit 2004-05 Coordinated Compliance Review (CCR) Report – Part I and II information generated using their local GradStar MIS.

As Table A shows, the sample of 53 agencies that voluntarily submitted information were quite similar in terms of county population density the 142 agencies funded during the 2004-05 school year. Table B shows that the 53 agencies accounted for just over 52% of the students served state-wide during the 2004-05 school year.
